#### DOHENY STATE BEACH AQUARIUM/ INTERPRETIVE CENTER FIELD TRIP

When: Monday September 28th at 10:00 AM

Where: 25300 Dana Point Harbor Drive, Dana Point, CA 92629

**Directions:** From the south, exit I-5 @ Beach Cities/ Camino Las Ramblas. Turn left onto Dana Point Harbor Drive. State Beach entrance will be left at first traffic light. From the north, exit I-5 at PCH/ Camino Las Ramblas, bear right. Turn left onto Dana Point Harbor Drive. State Beach entrance will be left at first traffic light. Aquarium is located directly next to entrance/ parking kiosk. Park in the first area to the right of kiosk.

What: Doheny State Beaches Visitor Center is a wonderful place to learn about the local sea, land and water animals that live in our environment. There is a 900-gallon tide pool exhibit and 5 other aquarium tanks with various fish, rays, lobster and more. On display are bones and skeletons of eels, whales, and dolphins. Examples of the many birds and mammals that live amongst us including cougars and seals as well bird life as well. There is a butterfly garden on site as well that the children can enjoy.

**Details:** We will tour the aquarium and butterfly gardens in two separate groups so that we don't overcrowd any one area. Bring a picnic lunch and blanket. We can picnic after on the grass lawn or tables between parking area and beach.
